He has held many high-ranking positions in government and in the private sector, including Deputy Undersecretary of and also chief environmental counsel for the Department of the Interior. Later, he was a Director of the environmental valuation practice at Deloitte & Touche LLP and, more recently, a Director of PricewaterhouseCoopers.

Eastin is a recipient of the Army Medal for Distinguished Civilian Service, United States Marine Corps Commendation for his outstanding efforts in advocating for Marine Corps programs before Congress and in addition, the United States Navy Medal for Distinguished Public Service. He holds a Master of Business Administration from the University of Cincinnati and a Juris Doctor from the University of Chicago.
